

CITY OF SEDGWICK MUNICIPAL SWIMMING POOL RULES

The following rules will be in effect for the entire season. These rules have been established for the benefit and safety of all patrons. By enforcing these rules we believe we can operate a safe and clean pool for the enjoyment of the entire community.

1. A Lifeguard must be present when swimmers are in the pool or within the pool area.
2. No running or pushing allowed within the pool area.
3. No dunking or throwing people in the pool.
4. Children 7 and under must be accompanied by a parent or responsible guardian 18 years of age or older while in the pool area.
5. Persons will avoid the use of profanity, vulgar remarks or improper behavior in the pool area.
6. No alcoholic beverages or person under the influence of alcohol will be permitted in the pool area.
7. Anyone wishing to enter the deep end must be able to swim across the pool and back unless under close supervision by an adult or Lifeguard.
8. No glass articles in the pool area or bathhouse.
9. No smoking.
10. No hanging or playing on the pool safety ropes.
11. Proper swimwear must be worn and is subject to the approval of the Pool Manager. Street clothes, jeans, cut-offs, gym clothes, casual shorts and thongs are not allowed in the pools or slides.
12. The pool will be cleared every hour for a ten-minute break.
13. Concessions items must be consumed within and are restricted to the designated concessions area.
14. Unnecessary conversations with the Lifeguards on duty is not permitted.
15. People in street clothes are not permitted in the pool area. Skates and skateboards must be left in the office.
16. Approved flotation devices are allowed in the shallow area only.
17. No pets are allowed in the bathhouse or the pool area.
18. Fighting will not be tolerated. Persons involved will be asked to leave the pool, pool area and surrounding property. Management will not hesitate to contact the police.

DIVING BOARD RULES

1. Only one person on the diving board at a time.
2. Only one bounce on the diving board.
3. No playing or trick diving on the diving boards.
4. Dive straight off the board only.
5. No swimming in the diving area under the diving board.
6. The area in front of the diving board must be cleared before diving.
7. Hanging from the board is not allowed.
8. After entering the water, swim to the nearest ladder or forward into the shallow area.

SLIDE RULES

1. Only one person on the slide or ladder at a time.
2. Slide in a front sitting position only.
3. The area in front of the slide must be clear before sliding.
4. After entering the water, quickly move out of the way for the next person.
5. Water slide rules will be strictly enforced including age and height restrictions.
No swimsuits with metal decorations or rivets will be allowed on the slides.

* Patrons must obey the directives of lifeguards at all times. Patrons failing to follow rules or directives are subject to eviction and suspension from the premises without refund of admission fee.

Whenever it is deemed necessary in order to protect the health and safety of participants, the management is authorized to issue and place into effect such rules either printed or verbal.

City of Sedgwick and pool staff are not responsible for lost or stolen property. Valuables should be left at home and patrons are advised to utilize available storage lockers.
