#### **RESOLUTION NO. 09072022**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS REGARDING THE GOVERNING BODY'S INTENT TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

**WHEREAS**, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Sedgwick was calculated as 71.293 mills by the Harvey and Sedgwick County, County Clerks; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City of Sedgwick will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body intends to hold a hearing and hear testimony from all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard as required by state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF :

Section 1. The Governing Body of the City of Sedgwick hereby sets a public hearing regarding its intention to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate for Wednesday, September 7, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. to be held at Sedgwick City Hall, 520 N. Commercial Avenue, Sedgwick, Kansas and directs that notice of the public hearing be given as required by state law.

Section 2. The Governing Body of the City of Sedgwick expresses its intention to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate with a maximum mill levy of 74.990 mills.

Section 3. The Governing Body of the City of Sedgwick directs the City Clerk to provide this resolution and the intent to Exceed Revenue Neutral Rate (RNR), attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference, to the Harvey and Sedgwick County Clerk as notice of the City's proposed intent to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 891

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A COMMON CONSUMPTION AREA AND AUTHORIZING THE POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES AND ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR WITHIN ITS BOUNDARIES, AND REPEALING ANY AND ALL OTHER FOREGOING ORDINANCES, OR PORTIONS THEREOF, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS K.S.A. 41-2659 allows cities to establish a common consumption area and to authorize the possession and consumption of cereal malt beverages and alcoholic liquor within such common consumption area; and

WHEREAS the City of Sedgwick ("City") is the owner of three (3) municipal parks, identified as the Sedgwick City Park, the Sedgwick Pocket Park, and the Mayor Donald K. DeHaven Memorial Park, all located within the Sedgwick city limits and all designated to serve as a public gathering place for special events, civic -events- and-community celebrations; and

WHEREAS the City desires to establish common consumption areas, as further defined herein, to allow the possession and consumption of cereal malt beverages and alcoholic beverages within each of the three (3) identified parks, namely Sedgwick City Park, the Sedgwick Pocket Park, and the Mayor Donald K. DeHaven Memorial Park and associated public right-of-way, subject to certain rules and regulations.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNNG BODY OF TI-IE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE: In accordance with K.S.A. 41-2659, and amendments thereto, the Governing Body hereby establishes the areas known as Sedgwick City Park, the Sedgwick Pocket Park, and the Mayor Donald K. DeHaven Memorial Park as common consumption areas (the "City Parks CCA") consisting of certain outdoor areas located within the parameters of the Sedgwick City Park, the Sedgwick Pocket Park, and the Mayor Donald K. DeHaven Memorial Park and associated city rights-of-way, as designated on the map, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, excluding any and all areas which otherwise become subject to a license issued pursuant to the Kansas liquor control act or the club and drinking establishment act. The boundaries of the City Parks CCA shall be clearly marked using a physical

barrier or any apparent line of demarcation. Any City right-of-way laying within the boundaries of the City Parks CCA may be included within the boundaries of the City Parks CCA when: (I) a Special Event Permit has been issued for the selling of cereal malt beverages and alcoholic beverages in, or connected with, the City Parks CCA; AND (2) the right-of-way has been barricaded from vehicle traffic.

SECTION TWO: The Governing Body hereby authorizes the possession and consumption of cereal malt beverages and alcoholic liquor in the City Parks CCA; provided, however, that a common consumption area permit ("Permit") for the City Parks CCA has been issued to the City by the State of Kansas, Director of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control ('Director") in accordance with K.S.A. 41-2659, and amendments thereto. The possession and consumption of cereal malt beverages and alcoholic liquor within the City Parks CCA is only permitted between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m., midnight, Sunday through Saturday.

SECTION THREE: All cereal malt beverages and alcoholic liquor removed from a licensed premises authorized to participate in the City Parks CCA shall be served in a container that displays the licensee's trade name or logo or other identifying mark that is to the licensee.

SECTION FOUR: The possession or consumption of cereal malt beverages and alcoholic liquor purchased outside of the City Parks CCA shall not be permitted inside the boundaries of the City Parks CCA.

SECTION FIVE: No open container of cereal malt beverages and alcoholic liquor, purchased within the City Parks CCA, shall be removed from the boundaries of the City Parks CCA.

SECTION SIX: Inappropriate conduct shall not be permitted within the boundaries of the City Parks CCA and any person engaging in such inappropriate conduct shall be subject to removal from the designated premises. Inappropriate conduct may include but is not limited to fighting, use of profanity or indecent language, harrassment, destruction of property, lewd or lascivious acts, or committing any violation of law or City Code.

SECTION SEVEN: All licensees approved by the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control to participate in the City Parks CCA shall at all times comply with any and all federal, state and city laws or regulations pertaining to the purchase and sale of cereal malt beverages and alcoholic liquor.

SECTION EIGHT: The Governing Body hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to take all reasonably necessary actions, including but not limited to the execution of all documents and instruments, to obtain a Permit for the City Parks CCA on behalf of the City.

SECTION NINE: Subject to receipt of the Permit as described in Section Two, the Governing Body hereby authorizes the City Administrator or their designee to establish rules and regulations pertaining to the use of the City Parks CCA and activities therein. A copy of the rules and regulations shall be available at the office of the City Clerk during regular business hours, on the website maintained by the City, and posted in the CCA. Any violation of such rules and regulations, any official City signage, state law or regulations, or the oral direction of any City employee or authorized volunteer shall be grounds for expulsion from the designated premises and criminal sanctions or any other remedy available under

SECTION TEN: Repeal: Any and all other and foregoing ordinances in conflict herewith shall be the same are hereby repealed local, state or federal laws.
